

## HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY FOR NIKO EXTRUSIONS LTD

- It is our policy that this Company's operations shall be conducted in such a way as to ensure, so far as is reasonably practical, the health, safety and welfare of all our employees by adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities and that our activities will not affect the health and safety of others. (**Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974**)

- The Company shall instigate such measures it considers appropriate to prevent accidents and cases of work related ill health.
- The Company shall maintain a clean, safe and healthy working environment.
- The Company shall prior to commencing any work, actively consult with employees on all matters concerning health and safety.
- The Safety Policy will be reviewed annually and monitored in order to meet the current legal requirements, new safety legislation, codes of practice and improved working practices. The Policy and subsequent revisions will be brought to the attention of all employees.
- The Company will ensure compliance of the Safety Policy requirements by policing and maintaining a thorough monitoring programme of the Policy.
